

Covid-19 hits everyone. But what also becomes apparent in the last few days: not all people are equal before a virus. Those who do not have health insurance, who are at the immigration office, at the social welfare office, have more problems in everyday life. We do see: the situation for people in collective accommodation is now even more difficult and dangerous. Everywhere people show solidarity with their neighbors. We want solidarity for all people!

We are the organization **Infobus Leipzig**. We demand that everyone can live in the place of their choice. We find it wrong that the rights of people in Germany and the EU are restricted or denied based on their origin and residence status. We therefore offer free legal advice for people in the asylum procedure. We are on the side of the people we advise. We advise independently of state and religious institutions. In order to protect one another, our consultations in Eisenbahnstraße 125 will be canceled for the next time! But we still remain contactable! Both for legal questions (e.g. handling mail from the immigration office, BAMF or court) as well as for questions about dealing with the current exceptional situation (e.g. the shared accommodation in which I live has been placed in quarantine: what can we demand from the home management and how can we enforce this?) Together we try to understand the situation and consider what can be done. We will forward it to other contact persons or try to make the problem public.
